


## Wöhr Parking Systems



### Wöhr Multiparker automatic system for The Cube, Birmingham

Wöhr Parking Systems, the UK's leading supplier of mechanical parking solutions for residential and commercial applications, is currently installing a Multiparker 760 system at Birmingham's striking new mixed-use development, The Cube.

A modern, efficient and fully automatic system, Multiparker 760 is installed within a multi-storey concrete structure, with cars being transported to and from parking spaces using lift and shuttle technology.

Upon completion in mid-2010, the Wöhr system will provide 339 parking places in a three-storey underground car park at The Cube, and represents the largest single installation completed by the company in the UK to date. In keeping with the contemporary design and high quality specification that characterises the building, the system will provide residents and tenants with the latest in parking technology, delivering a highly efficient service.

When parking their cars, drivers initially enter one of four lift-garages at ground level, exit their car and use their personal swipe card to activate the system. Their car is then automatically transferred below ground to a parking bay – tall enough to accommodate SUV, MPV and 4x4 vehicles. When drivers return to the garage to collect their car, the system automatically delivers it back to them within a maximum of 120 seconds.

Neil Edginton, Director of Birmingham Development Company (BDC) and construction arm BuildAbility, said: "Having four entrance/exit garages means that the system parks vehicles quickly and efficiently. It also ensures that cars are returned to their owners within a maximum of two minutes – it would probably take longer than this to walk to a car in a traditional car park!

"If we had taken the traditional route of using a ramped car park, we would have lost a lot of retail space, whereas this solution makes the most efficient use of the space below The Cube, as well as providing tenants with a high level of security.

"From the outset, we wanted The Cube to be the most spectacular building in the region and features like the car park, the glazed rooftop restaurant and the twisting glass atrium that will reach up through the building are really bringing the vision to life."
